Mrs Price talked about it being Anti-Bullying week next week in school and asked if children could be bullied on a tablet. They all didn't realise that they could! Mrs Price gave some examples of cyber bullying at an appropriate level and shared the online bullying poster which is going to be sent to all parents ion Monday and will be available in the website.

Finally, we talked about some parental feedback from the parent view questionnaire and talked about although we have to be safe on social media, it can be used in a sensible way as a form of communication. One parent has identified that the schools Instagram account needs to have a wider range of children photographs from different classes. FV nominated Mr Peach (IT apprentice) to take more photographs across school every day to send to Miss O hare rather than waiting for teacher to send them. Mr Peach was happy with this.

Mr Richins talked about us receiving the National Online Safety accreditation within school. Next time he will take a photograph of the Online Safety Committee with the award.
