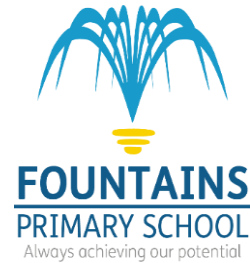


Eco Committee Meeting Agenda.

Agenda:

1. Introduce and welcome new members of the Eco-Committee.
2. Talk about the importance of recycling and introduce collection of plastic bottle tops for the community group - 'Burton Rerun'. Design a poster for the box.
3. Eco-School 'Cut your Carbon' campaign for the month of November.

Minutes:

1. Staff and pupils introduced themselves as part of the new Eco-Committee team and discussed what was important to them in terms of the environment and what action they feel we need to be taking as a school.
2. We talked about what things we value in terms of the environment and recycling was on top of the agenda. We discussed the possibility of getting involved in a community-based project with Burton Rerun and how we could save bottle tops to help and donate them to the project. Burton Rerun are a community-based project whose ethos is the Four R's - Reduce, Reuse, Repair and Recycle. Their mission is to collect recyclable items to fund a community workshop and enable the community to live more sustainably.

Pupils designed the front label for the box for the bottle tops, so that it could stay in the main reception area, where parents/carers, staff and pupils can access it.

3. We discussed the Eco-School initiative for the month of November to 'Cut Your Carbon', which promotes and details 9 simple actions, we could all take both at home and school, which will reduce emissions and benefit our planet. Each class representative took a copy of a poster and checklist for their class to encourage participants.
