



*8 of these children now have their attainment measured by an Alternative Curriculum, the graphs below demonstrates their average overall attainment, across all areas.




3 year Trend – Year 6 Attainment for pupils following the Autism Progress and Engagement Curriculum









Progress in Year 6

Whole cohort

91% of children made progress in every area tracked over the Key Stage.

Functional Curriculum - 31 children (9 children are following the Autism Progress or engagement Curriculum and are also taught Pre-Key Stage Standards for English and maths)

96% of year 6 children made progress in every area tracked.

Autism Progress Curriculum - 6 children

67% of children made progress in every area tracked of that 17% made accelerated progress in every area tracked.

Engagement Curriculum - 2 children
