We also discussed Online Safety Day which will take place on Tuesday 10th February. On this day, the school hall will be out of use all day and school dinners will take place in classrooms. Children across the school will be involved in a range of online safety activities and discussions. Teachers will be spending time on the day talking to children about how to stay safe online, using the resources provided to support lessons. In addition to this, each class will also teach an online safety lesson as part of one of their topic sessions either on the day itself or at another point during the week. Starfish, Octopus, Rays, Lobsters and Dolphins – will be taking part in an iVengers online safety workshop in the hall (please see the attached timetable for more details). These sessions will help pupils explore online risks and learn practical ways to keep themselves safe.
